Description

I am unable to build a rocket with a liquid fuselage (tested fl-t100 and fl-t200) in either Science or Career mode. I can select the fuselage, but when I try to attach it to what has been built the fuselage disappears upon click. From then on I cannot:

- move or delete the craft,
- exit vehicle assembly,
- attach new parts,
- move or delete any extraneous floating parts

I can press ctrl+Z to undo the fuselage and then I can perform the actions I listed above. This is the only way I have found to get out of the problem.

I do not experience this issue when:

- I start building a rocket from the fuselage, but if I try to launch I receive a message that the craft will not be controllable; I assume that part is by design.
- I use only solid rocket boosters
- In sandbox mode

KSP v1.11.0
