I would suggest you verifying your installation - the size of KSP.exe it reports does not match the size of the demo .exe in my archive. It doesn't come from the Steam, though, I downloaded it directly from the KSP site.

Also check if you have enough free memory - at least 3 GB should be available to run KSP.

Started KSP.exe and crashed immediately, I checked into my "free" memory and while there is a rather large surplus "available" memory (around 3gigs in fact) the "free" memory available is rather low, between 1-25ish MB or so. I suppose this is most likely the problem although I still suspect it's something to do with this laptop not supporting "D3D" or whatever too, so unless you think there is something that can be done I'm just going to forget about all this for awhile. I've always thought this laptop was pretty good so I can't vvery well justify a upgrade simply to try KSP:)
