Description

The part, originally from the 'asteroid day' mod, has attachRules = 1,0,0,1,0 so if we

- 1) Start building a new craft
 - 2) Select SENTINEL as root
 - 3) Select a probe core to stack on the bottom node of the SENTINEL
- the probe core cannot be attached to the node.

To workaround, start over with some other planned part as root, and stack the SENTINEL on top of that.
