Then I go back to the VAB and it still says "Requires Entry purchase". So I go back to the R&D and the part has duplicated itself with the new duplicate not being purchased. So i purchase the part and go back to the VAB. In the VAB it still says "Requires Entry purchase". Going back again to the R&D I find the part has once again duplicated. I have repeated this 10 times or more and it will seemingly just keep duplicating. Pictures are attached to help and support what I described above.
