### **Description**

When you focus/aim your camera at a radially attached part and then toggle an animation on said part i.e. Mystery Goo, the camera (in flight mode) goes black with the UI still rendering over the top. You can toggle into Map View but when toggling back to flight mode, sometimes the camera is still black and other times it resolves itself. You can toggle the animation again to reinstate the camera issue.

Turning off full screen so KSP could get a resolution of 2560x1440 (via my two monitors) I still couldnt recreate the bug

Looking up monitors that support that resolution Try turning off g-sync if you have it on. Its a extreme guess.

### Suggestions:

- 1. Try turning off g-sync if you have it on your monitor. Your video card that is a NVIDIA GeForce GTX 980 Ti does support it.
- 2. Try changing between full screen and it being not full screen
- 3. If you are using multiple screens, try it only on one.
- 4. Update video drivers

Trying the suggestions is just to help figure out what the issue is so squad can fix it
