Description

When constructing a spaceplane using Mk1 Liquid Fuel Fuselage, the part gets re-skinned (the graphic changes from the rocket fuel style paint job to the jet fuel style paint job) and becomes locked and labeled as experimental, despite having the Aviation technology, which unlocks the part, after doing any of the following:

- launching - it's possible to launch once, but any attempt to load and launch the plane again will be blocked due to locked parts
- duplicating
- place multiples of the part in symmetry mode - the one that is duplicate will be locked, while the original will not

This issue is consistently reproducible with no mods installed.
