For "synchronous orbit around Duna" it seems like the game forgets that lke is already occupying that orbit. What's fascinating is how this mission seems to be given in the same area, directly under lke, every time it pops (this is not the first time I've seen this, but it is the first time I've posted about it).

Maybe there's a line intending to avoid this issue that actually guarantees it will be eaused?

Every time I've seen the "maintain a synchronous orbit above a specific area of Duna" contract (I've seen this at least twice myself, posted the most recent example here, the ticket is the same issue), the specific area is always directly below Ike.

As Ike is already in a synchronous orbit around Duna, achieving orbit above the designated area will result in the craft leaving Duna's Sol and entering Ike's, thus making the contract impossible to complete.

Perhaps there's a line in the code that was designed to prevent this, that instead causes it?
