Description

"Unlike LF (Liquid Fuel) engines, where you can adjust the throttle during flight, once you light **an** SRB, it burns at a constant thrust till it's out of fuel. We can, however, use the **throttle** limiter as we did on the "Swivel" to set that constant thrust before we roll out to the launch pad."

The "an" should an "a" and "throttle" should be "thrust".
